

# **2020 NERRC Drivers Championship Rules**

# **Driver Eligibility**

- Drivers holding valid SCCA Competition Licenses or certain drivers with Novice Permits, and all others allowed to compete in SCCA events, per the current GCR.
- Drivers must compete in an eligible car of the same class in at least 2 weekends during the 2020 NERRC race schedule.

## **Car Eligibility**

- While competing for points, each car must visibly display the 2019 NERRC Championship stickers provided by Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park on each side of the vehicle. Placement to be decided by the car owner.

Each eligible class champion will win a Test Day or Club Day for use in 2021 at Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park courtesy of Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park, along with a trophy TBD by New England Region. #### **2020 NERRC Race Schedule**

Weekend 1 -- July 13-14 Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park (Combined with MAJORS championship series)

Weekend 2 -- August 8-9 NHMS

Weekend 3 – August 22 Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park (night race)

Weekend 4 – September 12-13 Palmer Motorsports Park

Weekend 5 -- October 2-3 **Championship weekend** at Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park (Combined with **NEDIV** championship series)

# **2020 Scoring Rules**

- Your best 8 finish points in class for the year will count towards your points for the championship.
- Finish points are calculated for each "NERRC Race" and do not include qualifying or practices.
- The last NERRC race of the <u>Championship weekend</u> at Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park is worth Double Points. The other "NERRC Races" that weekend will be worth normal points.

<sup>-</sup>For a DNF you are awarded points accordant to your DNF finishing position in class.

**Tie Breakers** will be determined by adding your next, highest finish points until a winner is determined. Example: If when calculating your best 8 finishes you and any number of other drivers are tied, then a 9th race finish will be counted to see if a winner is determined. If a tie still exists, 10 races will count. This process will continue until a winner is chosen.

## **OTHER ITEMS**

Point loss from exclusions, disqualifications, protests, etc. may parallel GCR National event rules. The voting NER CRB will rule on situations not in the GCR. All non-GCR regional class rules can be found at <a href="https://www.nediv.com">www.nediv.com</a>
