I received the City of Rochester Special Event License for the 10/24 at Rochester Fairgrounds after the Fair contacted Rally about having a RX this fall. I'm assuming that they noticed the missing income from not having us there. We are maintaining the rental rate that we had in 2019.

I visited a new potential RX site in Union, Maine last month and intend to speak with the landowner this week to schedule a "work day" and site test "RX" this fall if possible. If not, we will get on the schedule for next year.

We held an event at 508INTL in Charlton, MA on September 19. It was limited to 50 persons so we allowed 45 drivers. It was fun for everyone, the site held up well. The 508 staff wants us back so we are going back on 12/5 for the last event of the year. MA Governor Baker has increased the outdoor attendance limit to 100 people so we will increase the number of drivers for this event to increase revenue but still be in compliance with Covid-19 State Guidelines.

We will be doing Joker Lap at Canaan Motor Club on November 21. It's later this year due to another club renting on the first full weekend of November so we moved it to later in the month.

It's turning out to be a busy end of the year for RX, Roadrally and RallySprints.
