#### 2022 Yearbook

Production of the 2022 Pit Talk Yearbook is almost complete. Drafts of the printed publication have been sent to a few BOD members and contributors for their review and input. Once finalized, it will be sent off to the printer. Costs for printing the yearbook this year did increase - a 5% increase was budgeted, but actual costs were closer to 20%. Paper, printing, mailing services, and postage all saw significant increases. The RE and Treasurer were notified and the difference of \$1100 approved. However, whereas last year we had just four advertisers in the yearbook, this year we have double that at eight. Total ad revenue is \$2015 which greatly helps offset the increased expenses.
